#### COMMUNITY NEWS AND INFO

A Willmar Pride worship will be held at Bethel on Saturday, June 7<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm in the Bethel sanctuary. Open to all! Preaching at the worship will be Aubrey Thonvold, a daughter of Bethel and playing the cello will be Paul Benson, a son of Bethel. A pop-up choir will be part of the service – any interested singers are invited to join. Choir rehearsal will be on the day of the service, Saturday, June 7<sup>th</sup> from 4:30-5:30pm in the Bethel choir loft.

Family Promise of Kandiyohi County... Family Promise (the shelter where families live is in the northern portion of downtown Willmar) exists to serve homeless families in our area and help them stabilize their family, work life, and help them secure housing. Bethel is a sponsor church, and we partner with The Catholic Area Faith Community of Jesus our Living Water to provide a week of food through grocery shopping and providing 3 hot meals every 10-12 weeks. Currently, Family Promise is serving: Family of 3 (Father, Daughter 3, Daughter 4), Single Female 60, Family of 2 (Mother, Daughter 9), Family of 3 (Mother, Son 16, Son 9), Family of 4 (Father 34, Daughter 12, Son 9, Grandfather 60), Family of 2 (Mother 36, Son 2), Family of 3 (Father, Mother, Son 4), Single Female 43. Lutheran Social Services of M.X... Bethel is the Willmar hub for LSS' Meals on Wheels program. Four routes bring meals to approximately 40-50 units on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. Routes depart between 10:30-11:00 am and are typically completed within one hour.
