COMMUNITY NEWS AND INFO

Litheran Social Services of McN...
Bethel is the Willmar hub for LSS' Meals on Wheels program. Four routes bring meals to approximately 40-50 units on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. Routes depart between 10:30-11:00 am and are typically completed within one hour.

Family Promise of Kandiyohi County... Family Promise (the shelter where families live is in the northern portion of downtown Willmar) exists to serve homeless families in our area and help them stabilize their family, work life, and help them secure housing. Bethel is a sponsor church, and we partner with The Catholic Area Faith Community of Jesus our Living Water to provide a week of food through grocery shopping and providing 3 hot meals every 10-12 weeks. Currently, Family Promise is serving: Family of 3 (Mother 33, Son 15, Daughter 9), Family of 3 (Mother 33, Son 12, Daughter 4), Family of 5 (Mother 39, Daughter 12, Daughter 6, Son 4, Son 2), Single Female 36, Family of 2 (Mother 44, Son 12), Family of 2 (Father 36, Son 12).
