COMMUNITY NEWS AND INFO

Family Promise of Kandiyohi County... Family Promise (the shelter where families live is in the northern portion of downtown Willmar) exists to serve homeless families in our area and help them stabilize their family, work life, and help them secure housing. Bethel is a sponsor church, and we partner with The Catholic Area Faith Community of Jesus our Living Water to provide a week of food through grocery shopping and providing 3 hot meals every 10-12 weeks. Currently, Family Promise is serving: Family of 3 (Father 34, Daughter 12, Son 9), Family of 3 (Father 48, Mother 38, 4year old), Family of 2 (Husband 26 & Wife 25), Family of 4 (Mother 31, Daughter 10, Daughter 5, Daughter 3), Family of 3 (Mother 34, Son 8, Daughter 2), Family of 3 (Mother 33, Son 15, Daughter 9) Single Female 43.
