## **PURPOSES AND AIMS**

Each session is divided into three parts:

### Pre-class work

This will normally take the form of a short reading, listening or writing exercise.

5-10 minutes

### Live lesson with a KSE teacher

You will join colleagues from other schools for a lesson with a KSE teacher. Each lesson will be structured around a central topic with plenty of opportunities for discussion.

50 minutes

### Consolidation work

At the end of each lesson, the teacher will set short tasks and suggest background reading

5-10 minutes
