# KSE*Live!*Introduction to CLIL

#### **PURPOSES AND AIMS**

The main purpose of this course is to provide teachers with an introduction to content and language integrated learning (CLIL). The focus of the course is on language development and exploring how the 4 Cs (critical thinking, communication, collaboration and creativity) play an important part of teaching in English.

### WHO IS THIS COURSE FOR?

KSELive!CLIL is a course designed for teachers of other subjects who need to use English in the classroom.

Teachers enrolled on the KSE*Live!*CLIL course are asked to provide their English language level upon enrollment. Each session is divided into three parts:

# Pre-class work

This will normally take the form of a short reading, listening or writing exercise.

5-10 minutes

# Live lesson with a KSE teacher

You will join colleagues from other schools for a lesson with a KSE teacher. Each lesson will be structured around a central topic with plenty of opportunities for academic discussion.

50 minutes

## **Consolidation work**

At the end of each lesson, the teacher will set short tasks and suggested reading

5-10 minutes

#### IN THE CLASSROOM
