



## **GMRC Official Lucky Duck Regatta Rules**

- 1.The event will be organized by the Great Miami Crew Lucky Duck Race committee.
- 2.Buyers will be purchasing a duck number(s), which will be assigned by a committee member at time of purchase.
- 3.Ducks are sold for \$5 each, they can be paid for with cash, check or credit card.
- 4.Individually numbered ducks will be sent into the Great Miami River for the race. First duck to cross is the finish is the “Grand Prize” winner, with ducks finishing 2<sup>nd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> place will also receive prizes.
- 5.Prizes will be awarded to the “owners” of the first five ducks that finish. First place will receive \$1,000, additional prizes will be awarded for second, third, fourth, and fifth place. Prize winners do not need to be present at the event to win prizes.
- 6.This event raises money for the Great Miami Rowing Center and programming for the Center. The organizers will endeavor to ensure a fair race, but those buying tickets need to accept that the race is a game of chance and a number of circumstances could occur in which an element of luck will favor a particular duck or adversely affect other ducks.
- 7.The organizers will try to contact all winning owners. The names of the winners will be placed on the Great Miami Rowing Center website and used in Great Miami Rowing Center social media. A list of winners also can be obtained by contacting the center.
- 8.It is the intention to hold the race at the scheduled date and time; unforeseen circumstances might cause this time and/or date to be changed.
- 9.Any disputes can be referred to the Great Miami Rowing Center Lucky Duck Race Committee. The committee’s decisions are final. Proceeds from the Duck Race will be used to support activities, operations, and equipment used at the Great Miami Rowing Center.
