Located in San Miguel de Allende, Hotel Matilda is connected to a shopping center. San Miguel de Allende Historical Museum and Fabrica La Aurora are cultural highlights, and some of the area's notable landmarks include El Jardin and Parish Church of San Miguel Arcangel. Traveling with kids? Consider Xote Aquatic Park, or check out an event or a game at Plaza de Toros San Miguel de Allende. Practice your golf swing with lessons and a golf course nearby, or enjoy other activities in the great outdoors, such as hiking/ biking trails and ecotours in the area.

This 32-room hotel may appear traditional, thanks to its colonial facade—but the sleek Hotel Matilda is anything but. There's a crazy video

installation set up behind the front desk, and the hallways are lined with contemporary artwork; and once you get to your room, you'll discover crisp white beds dressed with Egyptian cotton linens and slate gray accents. Photographs by Mexico City artist Eduardo Zaylan hang on the walls in guestrooms. Marble-clad bathrooms have Malin + Goetz products, and some have free-standing tubs, though the infinity pool (shaded by palm trees) and the rooftop bar are the true standouts. If you're looking for a boisterous party scene, this isn't it, but for a slick, adults-only auberge, you can't do much better.
