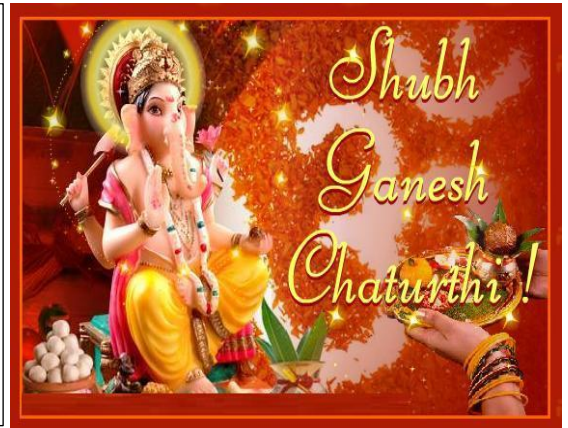

Ganesh Chaturthi

Sept 18th-Sept 21st, (Mon-Thurs), 2023

Ganesh Chaturthi is celebrated to commemorate the birth of Lord Ganesh - the son of Shivji and Parvatiji. The festival falls on the fourth day of the Hindu month of Bhadrapada (around August-September) starting on Shukla chaturthi and lasts for 10 days, ending on Anant Chaturdashi. Lord Ganesh is widely worshipped as the god of wisdom, prosperity, and good fortune. Ganapathi is also known as Vinayak, meaning one without a Nayak (master). He is the master of *Siddhi* and *Buddhi*. He is also called 'Vighneshwara', as he is the remover of all obstacles and the master of all forms of wealth.
