

Nag Panchami is one of the most sacred Indian festivals celebrated by Hindus to pay respect to the snake deities mentioned in the ancient Hindu Vedas and Puranas (sacred Hindu scriptures). Celebrated on Panchami, the fifth day of the moonlit fortnight in the Hindu month of Shravan (July/August), Nag Panchami commemorates the victory of Lord Krishna over the dreaded serpent Kalia.

According to the Bhavishya Purana, when men bathe the snakes Vasuki, Takshaka, Kaliya, Manibhadra, Airavata, Dhritarashtra, Karkotaka, and Dhananjaya with milk, on the fifth day of the bright fortnight of Shravan, they ensure freedom from danger for their families.
