



"SENIOR CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP"
April 17th & 18th 2021
RULE SHEET

Participants must have an SCGA handicap or equivalent to participate.

FORMAT:

36 Hole Medal Play Event – Including Overall Gross and Net Winners for The Championship; as well as Winners within Flights. Courses: Open/Western; Masters/Western.

FLIGHTS:*

#1: Age: 50 to 54; #2: Age 55 to 59; #3 Age 60 to 64; #4 Age 65 to 69; #5 Age 70

*Flights may change depending upon the number of entries and the Ages of players entering.

INDEX/HANDICAPS:

Playing Index will be calculated using player's April 1st index. Players receive 100% of their adjusted Handicaps.

TEES:

GREEN TEES: All play from Green Tees unless you qualify for the "Combo or Silver Tees".

To qualify for the Silver or either Combo 1 or Combo 2 tees:

Combo 1: age 65 with a 15 index or greater

Silver: age 70 with a 15 index or greater

Combo 2: age 75 with a 15 index or greater (subject to 50% regular play rule*).

If you are 70 and less than 75 and don't qualify for the Silver, you will play Combo 1.

If you are at least 75 and don't qualify for Combo 2, you will play the silver.

* at least 50% of your posted scores must be played from the Combo 2 tees (out of the last 20) in order to play from the Combo 2 tees.

PLAYOFF:

Overall Low Gross and Overall Low Net over the field will be the Tournament Champions. The same player cannot win both. Subject to Covid19 rules, in the event of a tie for Overall Gross, a sudden death playoff will be held immediately after play of Round Two. In the event a playoff is precluded by Covid19 rules, a date mutually convenient to the players will be decided upon for a 9 hole playoff. There will be no playoffs for Overall net ties or Flight winners. Overall net tie winners and Flight winners will share their respective titles. Overall and flight winners will qualify for Tournament of Champions.

PRIZES:

Overall gross and overall net, as well as flight gross and net, prizes will be awarded in Pro Shop Credit.

RULES:

USGA Rules in conjunction with the 2021 Local Rules of Braemar CC govern all play. The 14 Club Rule is in effect. Unless rakes are available you may lift, smooth and place in the bunker and you may play fairway divots (filled or unfilled) as ground under repair taking nearest point of relief. Flagsticks cannot be removed.

Scores will be posted as Tournament Scores. Submit scorecards to the Pro Shop immediately after round. Please do not congregate around the Pro Shop in accordance with the current "Safer at Home Order" and ClubCorp policy; failure may result in a penalty.

**Cancellations must be 72 hours before the tournament to avoid being charged.
Appeals will be considered by the Board.**
