About LADWP: Who we are





About LADWP: Water System



- Second largest municipal water utility in the nation
- Supplies approximately 159 billion gallons per year
- Three focus areas: safe drinking water, reliable water infrastructure, and sustainable local water supplies
- Water supply sources (5-yr Average FY 2016-2020) include: L.A. Aqueduct (48%), purchased water (41%), groundwater (9%) and recycled water (2%)

About LADWP: Power System



- Largest municipal electric utility in the nation
- In 2019-20, supplied more than 21,130 gigawatt hours to over 1.5M customers as well as 5,200 customers in the Owens Valley.
- Power resources include: renewable energy (37%), natural gas (24%), nuclear (14%), large hydro (4%), coal (21%)
- Responsible for inspection, maintenance or replacement, and operation of the following: energy generation, energy storage, transmission, and distribution






