PHOTOGRAPHY/IMAGE NEEDS

We have an ongoing need for photos of:

- Horse sports and horses in action:
 - Tent Pegging!
 - Skill-at-Arms/Cavalry
 - Mounted Archery
 - o Polo/Polocrosse/Arena Polo
 - Racing
 - o Trail/endurance
 - o Et cetera...
- General and seasonal horse care
- Grooming/horse husbandry
- Equine welfare/nutrition/feeding
- Horse health, veterinary, and farrier care
- Veterinary ailments/treatments
- Barns/stables, stalls, and horse housing
- Event scenes and/or schooling shots
- Infographics (statistics, drawings, charts, etc.)
- Photos that illustrate the horse/human bond
- Photos taken on private property must have an accompanying model release.

WHAT TO SEND

- We require high-resolution digital images in JPEG format.
 - Infographics may be formatted in .PNG or vector (preferred)
- Images should be a minimum of 300 dpi at full-page.

Please submit digital images according to the instructions below:

- Organize your submission(s) so that *ITP* can easily browse in galleries or folders by topic.
- Identify what's being shown with descriptive file names or include a caption list with the information (.docx or .PDF formats only).
- Information about the nature of your submission (on a specific topic, or for a particular article/issue) is also helpful.
- With each digital submission, please include your name, address, email and phone number.

HOW and WHERE to SEND PHOTOGRAPHY/IMAGES

- Attach image files individually—do not send a zip file, or a link to a Dropbox or other location. If multiple files are being send, please indicate as such in the body of your email.
- Attach any photo permissions (model or professional release) that are required. Submissions without proper release/copyright permissions will <u>not</u> be published.
- *ITP* does not accept physical jump/thumb drives or hard-copy prints of images at this time.

WHAT to EXPECT

As a stand-alone magazine of its type, *ITP* is self-published and does not compensate you for your photography/graphics.

- Instead, your name/company will be credited in the front-matter of the magazine, and you will retain all original copyright(s).
