Phonemic Awareness



Phonemic awareness deals with the phoneme. It is the ability to hear and manipulate sounds aurally. A phoneme is the smallest unit of sound and phonics is the system in which sound structures and phonemes are representied.

Phonemic Skills



Individual Phoneme Isolation:

(beginning, medial, final) Isolates phoneme in given word.

Individual Phoneme Blending:

Blends phonemes to make a words.

Individual Phoneme Segmenting:

Identifies phonemes in words.

Syllable Manipulation

Syllable (onset-rime)

<u>Deletion</u>: Deletes onset and then rime in given words.

Syllable (onset-rime)

Substitution: Substitutes onset and then rime to make new words.



Phoneme Manipulation

Phoneme Deletion: Beginning and final.

Phoneme Addition: Adds phoneme to make a new word.

Phoneme Substitution: Substitutes a phoneme to make a new word.
