Welcome To The Legions League

With the introduction of The Legions League, we at Future Lore Studios, would like to welcome everyone here in the Discord Server to our ALL-NEW Online Casual & Competitive Play for Legions Realms at War TCG!

The Legions League is open to All Community Members that are interested in signing up! We will have a Sign-Up Sheet posted in the League Sign Up Channel here: https://discord.com/channels/901494215450697747/1058019138985005077 in the Server. Please make sure you read and follow the League Rules below, in order to partake/compete in The Legions League.

The Legions League Rules

As for how The Legions League Online Play will work, please read the following information:

The Legions League will be broken down into 3 Month Seasons (mirroring that of our LGS Campaign Events found in Legions Retailer Ally Stores), however it will be with a bit of a twist of course for Online Play.

Legions League Online Webcam Gaming (Player Setup)

Players will compete using a Webcam and/or Cell Phone and their real physical cards via the published Discord server.

Technical Requirements

- Webcam/ Cell Phone (1080p recommended; 720p minimum)
- Computer/Cell Phone
- Microphone
- Dedicated Playing Space (if using a playmat, please use one with darker colors to enable cards

to be more easily seen by your opponent).

Dedicated Playing Space Set Up & Online Gaming

- 1. Set up your dedicated playing space where your cards will be displayed for your opponent. This can be a Computer Desk, Kitchen Table, or any other flat Work Station that can fit a Tournament Legal sized Legions Realms at War TCG Playmat 14 Inches Tall by 28 Inches Wide.
- 2. Adjust your webcam's position so the playing space is shown in full. (To the best of your abilities, we have large Playmats after all). You must capture the entire game area the best you can, but MUST have the following sections viewable: your Deck, Discard Pile, Eradication Zone, and Other Cards being used in the play Area.
- **Note: Your face does not need to be captured on the webcam stream, but can of course if you wish to do a picture in picture with a dual camera setup.
- 3. When jumping into a Ranked Game, join an available TOURNEY TABLE in the LEGIONS LEAGUE RANKED section of the server.
- 4. When you join Tourney Table, and meet your opponent, there is an option in the Discord Server to begin a video chat. Press it, and your webcam will be enabled so your opponent can see your video feed.
- 5. You MUST have your microphone enabled so that you and your opponent can easily communicate with each other and with any Judges that enter the Tourney Table Channel.
- 6. All relevant cards must be ALWAYS kept in video view. (This includes your hand, so if not looking at it please represent it facedown somewhere on your viewable table space.)
- 7. Make sure to keep your hand of cards over the table so that cards do not fall to the floor.
- 8. All shuffling must take place on camera, otherwise your deck will not be considered randomized and a Game Warning will be issued by a Judge. When your opponent would normally cut your deck, you must ask how they would like it to be cut. (This includes all Plunder Keyword Abilities as well.)
- 9. In the case you need a Judge Ruling on a specific card interaction, sequencing of cards, or any violation of Legions League Tournament Rules, we ask that you, first and always be courteous of all player playing, and simply ask them if a Judge can be called. At this point you go to the Judge Call Channel under Legion League Ranked Section and @Judge in the Channel for a Role Call

for one of the Legions Judges. (Make sure in you @Judge Roll Call that you state the Tourney Table Number you are playing in). Please then wait for an available Legions Judge to answer, either via a Written Thread to the Question asked, or the Judge Joining your Tourney Table.

10. You are allowed to spectate Legions League games, and in fact it is encouraged to helping the community grow and interact. However, this does not mean that you as a spectator are allowed to interfere with, over complicate, judge, cast ruling judgements of a Legions League Ranked Game. That is a right only reserved for a Legions Appointed Judge. Also, there will be no harassing, interrogating, making fun of, or calling out competitors, before, during, or after Legions League Play. (Once again, all Discord, and Legions Official Tournament Rules Apply.)

Legions League Campaign Seasons (2023)

There will be 3 Legions League Campaign Seasons in the 2023 Calendar Year. We will be consciously skipping over Online Legions League Play for the Summer Months of July and August, and the Christmas Month of December; as typically these are busy schedule filled Months for our Online Legions Community, and therefore we feel time is best spent with Friends and Family!

Like stated prior, we are mirroring our In-Store Legions LGS Campaign Events and their corresponding Campaign Seasons. Therefore, we will be picking up and starting with Campaign Season 2 as we continue hosting them In-Store throughout the beginning of the New Year!

Campaign Season 2 (January, February, March)

Campaign Season 3 (April, May, June)

Campaign Season 5 (September, October, November)

**Note: This is for Legions League Campaign Seasons ONLY! Therefore, The Legions League has no affiliation to Win/Loss/Draw Points in regards to In-Store/In-Person Legions Siege Series Events or any Legions Rally the Realms Tournaments in the Past or Future. The Legions League is its own entity, and will be treated as a great way to build the community through happy, and healthy Casual/Competitive Online Gameplay (Particularly for Players and Fans that do not have a Local Game Store that carries Legions Realms at War TCG at this time).

Legions League Results

Legions League Points that are earned through Official Online Discord Webcam Legions League Games are accumulated over the course of an ENTIRE Campaign Season (3 Month Period)

We at Future Lore Studios, will need your help in keeping track of your Wins you earn through Legions League Play by requiring YOU, the player to submit YOUR individual Legions League Game Results for their Ranked Games through the League Results Channel found here:

These Ranked Games are to only be played Online using the Legions Realms at War Community Discord Server in the Legions League Ranked Tables Section (Any other Online game not played in this manner or in the appropriate section of the Discord Server will not count towards your point totals)

Your Individual Ranked Game Legions League Results Form REQUIRES you to fill out the Ranked Game Results Submission Form found here:

**Note: This is where you list your Discord Name, your opponent's Discord Name, the decks you both played with, the date in which the games were played, the time of day the games concluded at, the total games you and your opponent played (i.e. How many out of the Best of Three), and the results of the Best Of Three. You MUST report Wins, Loses, or Draws (if due to time restraints of individuals playing).

At the end of a Season (3 Month Period), a member of our staff here at Future Lore Studios (FLS), will be Direct Messaging (via Discord) all Top 12 Players from each 3 Month Campaign Season, at some point when the Active Season concludes. At that point we will be asking each player for their REQUIRED Shipping information, including a Full Name, Address, Postal Code/Zip Code, Phone Number, and Email Address (We will not ship to PO Boxes), in order to be able to send out all Legions League Tournament Winnings (Including Prize Promo Cards and Prize Playmats).
