

WICKED BULLET

MOGADISHU, Somalia

A dusty haze hung over the little cluster of mud and brick huts, and the smell of cooking fires filtered back to Sam Wick, lying prone beneath a mountain of mud and leaves.

He could hear the evening call to prayer sounding from a nearby mosque. A boy with a stick was herding his few goats across the stony ground to the east, trying to find something his animals could graze upon. The land was barren and bleak, like the lives of the few people who lived here. The temperature was approaching single digits at the end of a late December day. The stars had begun to pierce the darkness of the Indian Ocean sky with their twinkling brightness, though there was still light.

This was a region where the so-called development had not reached yet and probably never would. Wick couldn't care less about it. He was lying in that prone position for over four hours and perhaps would have to stay so for another four. His back had started to hurt, but he couldn't move. The mud and the leaves were now a solid mass that sheltered him. Any movement beyond what was permissible in that position would have nulled everything. He had to persist.

Once labeled the 'Switzerland of Africa,' Somalia had enjoyed almost a decade of democracy. After gaining independence from Britain and Italy in 1960, it held free and fair elections and was ruled democratically from 1960 to 1969.

The first elected President of Somalia, uniting the former British and Italian territories, was Adam Abdullah Osman, who reigned for seven years. He was succeeded, freely and peacefully, by Abdirashid Ali Sharmarke.

Sharmarke, however, was assassinated by one of his bodyguards in 1969.

The Speaker of the Somali Parliament, Mukhtar Mohamed Hussein, took over. Still, his brief, six-day tenure was cut short by a military coup led by General Siad Barre, ending Somalia's period of democratic government.

Whatever its faults – and there were many – Barre's 22-year rule created modern Somalia, building one of Africa's strongest armies and massively improving the literacy of the population. Yet Barre, who gained the support of the US and the Soviet Union, also dissolved parliament, suspended the constitution, banned political parties, arrested politicians, and curbed press freedom. From then, there was a downward trend in everything. A disintegration.

And every time things were going down; the military regime was becoming more brutal and dictatorial.

Opposition to the Barre government gradually increased, and in May 1988, encouraged by Ethiopia, the same northern tribes rebelled against Barre's dictatorship. This provoked the full force of his military power and aggression, and thousands of northern Somalis were killed.

Three years later, in 1991, both the northern and southern tribes, again supported by Ethiopia, rose against Barre. His grip on power had weakened, his former allies had abandoned him, and he was finally brought down. One outcome was the northern region proclaiming its independence and declaring itself as Somaliland. It maintains its separatism today but has hardly any international recognition.

But the other long-lasting outcome was a civil war, with myriad competing factions and frequent intervention by foreign powers and neighboring countries.

The nation fell apart as rival tribes emerged to battle for control.

And then came a monster famine that wiped out more than three hundred thousand people and killed more than seventy percent of the livestock.

The only thing left was fear. Predator warlords and their men preyed on destitute refugees swarming into camps. Mogadishu became a lawless city in a lawless land.

The rest of the world tried to help a dying country with food and aid. But the militias seized the distribution points and robbed relief planes as soon as they rolled to a halt. Nothing the United Nations did was enough to stop the starvation, disease, and raging civil war.

Eventually, the United Nations and the United States decided to launch a massive military intervention and commit thousands of troops. But the major warlords moved quickly to forge alliances among themselves to fight the Americans. They knew whoever was in control when the Americans arrived would most likely stay in power.

The situation stayed stable only for a year, till such time US troops remained stationed in Somalia. After the US forces were gone, warlords rose again after a lull in the action, and the most powerful took control of the meatiest of the regions.

After decades of civil war, the two of the biggest warlords decided to go for a truce, but it simply meant more bloodshed and oppression of the refugees and locals.

Wick watched as two Toyota SUVs sprinted from the north. They were followed by five more, packed with mercenaries. Each one of them had at least one innocent's blood on their hands. That was the critical criteria to be a part of any of those two clans. For Wick, every man in those SUVs was a prime candidate to be shot in the head. Enter the universe of Sam Wick thrillers.




