## **Packing Checklist**

The Bare Travel Necessities
Be sure to always pack and keep these important documents within reach.
□ Driver's license/ Other government photo ID □ Travel Insurance Policy Number and Contact Phone Number □ Birth certificate □ Boarding pass □ Passport/Visas □ Travel Documents/reservation itinerary □ Printed cruise ship luggage tags □ Credit or ATM Cards/Cash (recommend extra small bills for tips at the bar. \$1 per drink goes a long way when there are long lines). Casinos are on board most ships. □ Immunization records/COVID records if required □ Prescription/over the counter medications
Carry On Luggage  What goes in your carry-on is both an exercise in logic and an exercise in restraint. You don't want to pack large bottles of liquids that will only be confiscated at the airport. On the other hand, you might want a convenient outfit swap for that "worst case scenario" of an airline misplacing your luggage. If you want to hit the pool as soon as you arrive, keep your bathing suit in your carry-on. But if you're traveling from a warm climate to a cool one, pack a scarf or sweater. Here are the items we'd put in our carry-on luggage. And of course, those of you who need to stay plugged in always will need to make room for your electronics (and their chargers)
Casual change of clothes Formal change of clothes Extra pair of shoes Toiletries and necessities Important medications Bathing suit and sunscreen Entertainment or snacks for kids Laptop/tablet Charging devices for electronics
Checked Luggage  Always check with your airlines for checked baggage fees and to be aware of any additional fees for weight limits. Most credit card companies offer free checked baggage when you purchase your airline ticket using their branded credit card. If you plan to travel more than once in the next two years, you should consider getting a specific airline credit card as the cost for checked baggage over the course of two trips exceeds that of an annual cost of a credit card.
Now that you know where you're going and what you'll be doing once you get there, you'll need to pack accordingly. Keep in mind what activities you have planned, and the weather conditions during your travel. Some trips may take you through multiple climates, so bring a variety of clothes if needed.
