## <u>Timber Frame Workshop at the Timber Framing Learning Center of Western</u> <u>North Carolina</u>

July 21-26, 2025

**Intro**: Nothing says 'come on fall!' like a burn barrel full of pine off cuts and shavings! Hours of the class will be 8-5 each day, with 30 minutes to enjoy home cooked lunches, courtesy of my wife Becky! Click here for course curriculum.

<u>Location</u>: 1132 Old Fort Rd, Fairview, NC 28730. A small town in western NC, conveniently located near Asheville and Black Mountain, NC



Skills to be taught: Using square rule layout, we will teach plan reading, cutting the basic mortise and tenon joint, brace pockets, and fit-up and raising principles. You will have the opportunity to cut every joint in the frame. There is a sawmill onsite, so we can chat about milling. There will be a discussion on tool sharpening, as well. Dan just completed a Lumber Grading course, so there will be info on that topic, as well! Don't have all the tools? No worries, we have tools to lend!

<u>Lodging</u>: There are several options for Lodging. I can accommodate (1) 30 amp hook up with water, no sewer. The parking lot is gravel, but there is space to tent camp or park a van, etc. There is a clean shower in the shop available for use. On-site camping is free! Check out Airbnb for local deals! Also, there are many hotels in Asheville and Black Mountain.

<u>Cost</u>: 6-day Timber frame class: \$1,300, but register with paid deposit by May 21, 2025 and save \$100! Also, 'bring a friend' and save \$50 on the second registration! We welcome 'non-participating' partners for \$100 to cover the cost of lunch.
