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# ORDINANCE GRANTING THE RECORDER'S REQUEST TO USE MONIES FROM THE RECORDER'S RECORD PERPETUATION FUND TO SUPPLEMENT THE RECORDER'S 2024 BUDGET

- **WHEREAS**, pursuant to I.C. 36-2-3.5-5, the County Council shall adopt ordinances to promote efficient County Government; and
- WHEREAS, on June 14, 2011, the Lake County Council adopted Ordinance No. 1336B, the Ordinance Establishing the Lake County Recorder's Perpetuation Fund, Fund No. 179, a Non-Reverting Fund; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to I.C. 36-2-7-10.2(b), the Lake County Recorder by Affidavit has requested that the sum of \$4,332,448.24 of the Recorder's Perpetuation Fund be used to supplement payment of the expenses of her office for the 2024 calendar year (Exhibit "A"); and
- **WHEREAS**, pursuant to I.C. 36-2-7-10.2 (c), upon receiving the Recorder's Affidavit, the Lake County Council may adopt an Ordinance approving the Recorder's request.



The Indiana Public Defender Commission has implemented new caseload standards for the calendar year 2024. Our expenditures are reactive to the number of cases filed by the prosecuting attorney. Our office was a pilot test county for 2023 to implement the new caseload formulas and we will need an additional contract lawyer in each of the 4 courtrooms to handle the overflow and keep caseloads within permissible numbers to comply with the 40% reimbursement.

This year we were authorized by the Indiana Public Defender Commission to seek an appropriation of \$180,000 from Fund #1405 Line Item #63190 Other Professional Services as a one-time exception.

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE LAKE COUNTY PLAN COMMISSION'S UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE, ORDINANCE NO. 2560 AND

REPEALING AND RESCINDING THE UNINCORPORATED LAKE COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE AND LAKE COUNTY SUBDIVISION ORDINANCE REGULATIONS NO. 1670

EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2023, ORDINANCE NO. 1484A

- WHEREAS, on June 13, 2023, the Lake County Council adopted the Ordinance Adopting the Lake County Plan Commission's Unified Development Ordinance, Ordinance No. 2560, and Repealing and Rescinding the Unincorporated Lake County Zoning Ordinance and Lake County Subdivision Ordinance Regulations No. 1670; Effective October 1, 2023; Ordinance No. 1484A; and
- WHEREAS, the Lake County Council now desires to amend Ordinance No. 1484A, the Unified Development Ordinance, Ordinance No. 2560 (Exhibit "A"), specifically, Article 22/Terminology, Section 154-22-230 Definitions of Words and Terms Beginning with "S"; Article 12/Subdivision Design and Improvements, Section 154-12-50 Streets, Subsection E Street Rights-of-Way, Table 12-1; Article 12/Subdivision Design and Improvements, Section 154-12-50, Streets, Subsection B Right-of-Way Dedication; and Appendix 6: Road Construction Specifications.

## NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

That the Lake County Council now desires to amend Ordinance No. 1484A, specifically, the Unified Development Ordinance, Ordinance No. 2560 (Exhibit "A") as follows:

Article 22/Terminology, Section 154-22-230-Definitions of Words and Terms beginning with "S" as follows:

## **DELETE:**

Street, Principal Arterial

Major roads that provide a high degree of mobility and access control and function as the primary travel routes through urbanized area in the county, as identified in the Lake County Comprehensive Plan or other county approved transportation plan.

Street, Minor Arterial

Major roads that augment principal arterials by accommodating shorter trips with fewer or less stringent access controls, as identified in the Lake County Comprehensive Plan or other county approved transportation plan.

Street, Collector

Medium capacity, medium-volume streets with limited continuity. Collector

streets link arterial streets with local streets and provide inter-neighborhood street connections, as identified in the Lake County Comprehensive Plan or other county approved transportation plan.

### Street, Local

All streets other than arterial and collector streets. Local streets provide direct access to lots and generally accommodate shorter trips than arterial and collector streets.

## **INSERT:**

## Principal Arterial

These are major throughways that provide the best connectivity from one place to another, but are not controlled access. They are symbolized as red on the attached map. Examples include US-30, US-20, Michigan Blvd. in Michigan City, or Indianapolis Blvd. in Hammond.

### Minor Arterial

Also hold through traffic, but are best for connecting closer areas. They generally have slower speed limits and more curb cuts. They are green on the attached map. Examples include Sheffield in Dyer, Meridian Road in Porter County, and Johnson Road in LaPorte County.

## Major Collector

These roads collect local traffic. They are used more often than local roads, and have better connectivity than local roads. They are purple on the attached map. Examples include Greenwood Avenue in Michigan City, Division Road in Porter County, and 35<sup>th</sup> Street in Gary.

## Minor Collector

These roads are a lot like Major Collector, except they connect less roads than a Major Collector would. These are yellow on the attached map. Some examples are Manor Avenue in Munster, Burdick Road in Porter County, and Jackson Street in Michigan City.

### Local Road

(Thee are all roads that we have not classified). These carry local traffic. They could be around residential or business oriented areas.

Article 12/Subdivision Design and Improvements, Section 154-12-50, Streets, Subsection E, Streets Right-of-Way, Table 12-1:

## **DELETE:**

Eliminate the amount of required right-of-way for Principal Arterial Roadways of 120 feet.

## **INSERT:**

Replace the amount of required right-of-way for Principal Arterial Roadways to 100 feet.

<b>INSERT:</b>	(Add a sentence which states)

For Minor Subdivisions shoulder and ditch improvements are not required.

Appendix 6: Road Construction Specifications, Section 2:

# **DELETE:**

Eliminate the provision that where roadside swales are constructed, the side slopes shall not be of a steeper gradient than two (2) feet of horizontal measurement to one (1) foot of vertical measurement.

## **INSERT:**

Where roadside swales are constructed, the side slopes shall not be of a steeper gradient than three (3) feet of horizontal measurement to one (1) foot of vertical measurement.



I am writing to request placing an Amendment to my Consulting Services Agreement on the Council's September 12, 2023, Regular Meeting Agenda. This Amendment is attached for your review.

My 2023 Consulting Services Agreement authorizes me to provide **\$90,000** in consulting services at the rate of \$90.00 per hour. To date, I have provided **\$75,915** in professional services. The remaining balance on my contract is **\$14,085.00** and I believe this amount will be exhausted by mid-October. The requested Amendment seeks an additional **\$10,000** in compensation to provide essential grant-related services through the Council's December Regular meeting.

I am requesting this additional compensation for the following reasons:

- Completing the 2022 Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards (SEFA) for the County's Annual Report took longer than prior SEFA's due to using both Lawson and Oracle-Fusion financial systems to compile and verify federal grant payments and expenditures.
- SEFA quarterly updates are taking longer than previous updates since Oracle-Fusion financial system data (exported as Excel spreadsheets) require reformatting to manipulate grant-related financial data and perform necessary calculations.
- Performing SEFA quarterly updates require more time due to lump-sum grant payment postings to Funds <u>and</u> absence of descriptive information for grant payment postings in exported spreadsheets.

It is a pleasure serving as Lake County's Grants Management Consultant. I look forward to discussing this request for additional compensation and/or the attached Amendment with you.
