## lan's Story

- Kind, determined, and gifted young man
  - Driven and goal oriented
  - Didn't hesitate to help others
- Recognized his own struggles at an early age
  - "Angry all the time" at age 11
  - Struggled with performance expectations
  - Struggled socially, even in his own words
- Despite his own challenges, he reached out for help, and tried to help others
  - Encouraged younger swimmers
  - Looked out for the underdog
  - Spoke openly about his struggles







## lan's Story

- Diagnosed at 12 with depression and anxiety
- We tried to find treatment for him
  - First was Neurocore
  - Counseling
  - Psychiatry and medication
  - Cognitive behavior therapy
  - Psychiatric Emergency Services
- At Michigan he was surrounded with the best doctors and care in the country
- Sadly, even that was not enough

We lacked consistent, effective treatment where the <u>therapy came to lan</u>










- There are hundreds, if not thousands of awareness programs across the US
  - This is important, but not enough
- The problem is, there are far fewer treatment options
  - We've lost our community health facilities
  - Our law enforcement and ER's are overwhelmed
  - Patients are not getting the care they need
  - Result is lack of improvement, and worse, an increase in rates of suicide
- We can do better.
- We must BE BETTER



- We are here to share a vision for a new community mental health center
  - Breaks the mold
  - Provides proven, effective care with an evidencebased model
  - Can grow as needs do
  - ▶ Treats the most vulnerable
  - ▶ It does for others what Ian needed most himself
- We've all been deeply affected by lan's loss

We NEVER want this to happen to another one of our kids in this community again!







- The Ian Miskelley Be Better Mental Wellness Center
  - Based on established models of care
    - Crisis Now model (4 pillars)
      - ▶ Endorsed by National Action Alliance for Suicide Prevention
    - Zero Suicide model
  - Scalable
  - Provides most effective forms of treatment
    - Michigan Suicide Prevention Commission recommendations and best practices

We will **Be Better** by addressing the limited treatment options available in our community with the goal of **zero** suicides among those who seek our assistance.



- Bring care and support to the community and to those suffering from mental illness
  - Focus on adolescents 14-22 with anxiety and depression
  - Create a model that provides
    - Therapists who go to their patients (not vice versa)
    - Beds/rooms for emergency overnight stays for teens in crisis
    - Supplemental cost coverage if insurance doesn't cover it
    - Facilities for training programs, counseling sessions and group therapy
    - Partnerships with local entities to enable mental health treatment
    - Hotline for immediate assistance with an easy to remember phone number

#### What does it look like?

- Be Better will address the need for a comprehensive and coordinated system of care
- Clinical Philosophy will be relationship based
  - "It's about connection"
  - Relationships that are
    - Long term
    - Respond to emergency needs 24/7/365
    - Welcoming, tolerant, forgiving
    - Focused on the whole person
    - Focused on entire family and support network



#### Who will we serve?

- Be Better will serve the non-Medicaid eligible population in Ottawa County
  - Individuals aged 14-22 and their families and natural supports
  - Diagnosed with Mood Disorder
    - ▶ Major Depression, Anxiety Disorder
  - History of trauma
  - History of suicidal ideation or attempts
  - Family members who have lost a loved one to suicide



#### What services will we offer?

- Phase I Establishing the Clinical Foundation. Be Better will provide
  - Assessment and screening for mental illness and Suicidality
  - Suicide prevention training
  - Individual therapy
    - Appointment based and drop-in
  - Group therapy (Scheduled and drop-in)
  - Psychoeducation related to mental illness/suicidal ideation
  - Social engagement opportunities
  - Family support services
    - Family Therapy
    - ► Family Groups
    - Community Support Coordination
  - Community anti-stigma education
  - Bereavement services



Total funding required: \$1,500,000 Timing: 9-18 months

#### What services will we offer?

- In Phase II, Establishing Relationships Beyond Professional Care
- Be Better will provide
  - Recreational and Social Engagement Drop-in Center Services
  - Training and Development of Peer Support and Mentoring (Life Coach/Mentors/Sponsors)
  - Development of the Be Better App for 24/7 support



Total funding required: \$5,500,000

Timing: 12 months

#### What services will we offer?

- In Phase III, Establishing 24/7/365 Crisis Response
- Be Better will provide/Coordinate
  - Coordinate with Ottawa County Mobile Crisis Response and State Crisis Lines and Support
  - Assist in the development of Individual and Family Crisis Management Plans
  - Development of the Be Better App for 24/7 support
  - Development of 23:59 Crisis Beds



Total funding required: \$10,000,000 Timing: 18 months


#### How will we fund it?

- Be Better will be funded through a variety of sources
  - Donations/Fund raising
  - Commercial insurance (via our partnership with Mosaic Counseling)
  - Ottawa County Mental Health Millage (if eligible)
  - State of Michigan Line-item Budget Allocation
    - Pilot program
  - SAMSHA and Community Health Grants
  - United Way
  - Community Foundation of Holland/Zeeland Grants



### Where are we today?

- We've established the Ian Miskelley Memorial Fund at the Community Center of Holland/Zeeland
  - We have raised over \$43,000 from more than <u>250 business and personal donors</u>
  - We have established and awarded a scholarship for a local swimmer
  - We are now focusing our efforts on building this center
- We have established partnerships with state and local leaders
  - Mosaic Counseling
  - Mary Whiteford Michigian House of Representatives chair of budget committee
  - Ottawa County Mental Health Center
  - Be nice.
- We've developed a business plan
  - Mission and vision
  - Target market
  - Sources of funding
  - Growth plan
- We've developed a scalable, progressive service model
  - Counseling services
  - Mobile Crisis Team
  - Drop-in access
  - Short term stays (<72 hours)</p>
