LOVE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**


**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to establish an appropriation for Village Expenditure, and


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF  
CHESAPEAKE, COUNTY OF LAWRENCE, STATE OF OHIO, AND DECLARING IT AN  
EMERGENCY THAT:**

**SECTION 1** Appropriation in the General Fund (1000) in the amount of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) to HomeTown Love. This appropriation reflects the monies the village received from grants on behalf of HomeTown Love.

**SECTION 2** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be and is passed as an emergency measure, the emergency being the need to manage the affairs of the Village in a prudent and responsible manner. Said Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Chesapeake.
