AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO HOMETOWN LOVE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish an appropriation for Village Expenditure, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CHESAPEAKE, COUNTY OF LAWRENCE, STATE OF OHIO, AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY THAT:

SECTION 1 Appropriation in the General Fund (1000) in the amount of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) to HomeTown Love. This appropriation reflects the monies the village received from grants on behalf of HomeTown Love.

SECTION 2 That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be and is passed as an emergency measure, the emergency being the need to manage the affairs of the Village in a prudent and responsible manner. Said Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Chesapeake.
