Resolution 2023-4

A Resolution Declaring It Necessary to Renew the Tax Levy for the Adequate Funding of the Village Fire Department and Requesting the Lawrence County Auditor to Certify the Current Tax Valuation of the Village and Revenues that would be generated by the Renewal and Declaring an Emergency

WHEREAS, Council intends to place the issue of the renewal the fire tax levy on the November 2023 Ballot; and

WHEREAS, the law requires that the County Auditor certify the current tax valuation of the Village and the amount of revenue that would be generated by said renewal levy; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Chesapeake, Lawrence County, Ohio finds that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the limitation by law will be sufficient to provide an adequate for the necessary funding requirements of the Fire Department of said Village of Chesapeake, Ohio; and

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF CHESAPEAKE, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That the Village of Chesapeake, Ohio is seeking, pursuant to ORC 5705.19(I), to renew the 1.5 Mill levy for the purpose of providing and maintaining fire apparatus, appliances, buildings, or sites therefor, or sources of water supply and materials therefor, or the establishment and maintenance of lines of fire alarm telegraph, or the payment of permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighters or firefighting companies to operate the same, including the payment of the firefighter employers' contribution required under section 742.34 of the Revised Code.

Section 2. The question of levying said taxes shall be submitted to the electors of said Village of Chesapeake at the November 7, 2023, election to be held at the usual voting places within the Village of Chesapeake.

Section 3. A copy of this Resolution shall be immediately certified to the Auditor of Lawrence County; and this Council hereby requests that the County Auditor certify (1) the total current tax valuation of the Village of Chesapeake, and (2) the dollar amount of the revenue that would be generated by the levy, and (3) what the levy would cost a property owner on a property with a market value of \$100,000.

Section 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be and is passed as an emergency measure, the emergency being the need to manage the affairs of the Village in a prudent and responsible manner. Said Resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of Chesapeake.
