

## **QCMP SAR EQUIPMENT CHECKLIST**

- 1. Purpose The Queen Creek Mounted Sheriff's Posse Search and Rescue team must be able to fully support search and rescue operations without jeopardizing the health and well being of their animals, themselves, and the Group and without relying on others. Each member shall be able to provide food, water, equipment and supplies for their equine and themselves for up to three days.
- 2. Equipment Each member of the Queen Creek Mounted Sheriff's Posse Search and Rescue team shall own, maintain in good working order, and have the following times at all search callouts and training exercises.

SAR items needed at all times:	Items for overnight operations kept in truck or trailer:
<ol> <li>Slicker / poncho (rain gear)</li> <li>Toilet paper / tissues</li> <li>Strike anywhere matches in a waterproof container</li> <li>Compass</li> <li>Notebook and writing tools</li> <li>Trail marking tape – 2 colors florescent</li> <li>Whistle</li> <li>Signal mirror</li> <li>First aid kit (see Equipment List)</li> </ol>	<ol> <li>Sleeping bag, sleeping mat</li> <li>Tent – one person "backpack" type</li> <li>Hand towel</li> <li>Metal or other non-breakable drinking cup</li> <li>Eating utensils (fork, knife, spoon, etc.)</li> <li>Portable stove / fuel or ready to eat meals</li> <li>Medicine, personal hygiene items</li> <li>Food to stay away from base for 2 nights for equine / human</li> </ol> Recommended items for truck or trailer:
<ul> <li>10. Multi-tool / Leatherman / pocket knife</li> <li>11. Flashlight with strobe option</li> <li>12. Nylon paracord (50 feet)</li> <li>13. Sharpie markers</li> <li>14. Emergency "space" blanket</li> <li>15. Leather string / twine, etc.</li> <li>16. Canteen or other suitable water container</li> <li>17. Water purification tablets or "Life Straw"</li> <li>18. Collapsible water bucket / dog dish</li> <li>19. Portable phone battery charger</li> <li>20. Sunscreen</li> <li>21. Insect repellent</li> <li>22. Duct tape</li> <li>23. Sewing kit</li> <li>24. Disposable gloves (latex free)</li> <li>25. Gorilla Glue /super glue</li> <li>26. Extra batteries for flashlight</li> <li>27. Snacks, jerky, nuts, protein bars</li> <li>28. Water - 1 gallon per day required</li> <li>29. Sunglasses</li> <li>30. Cell phone</li> </ul>	<ol> <li>Picket rope or high-line</li> <li>Water / feed buckets</li> <li>Water – 15 gallons per equine / per day</li> <li>Equine feed – grain, hay, etc.</li> <li>Emergency flares</li> <li>Safety triangles / road markers</li> <li>Fire extinguisher</li> <li>Wheel chocks</li> <li>Jumper cables</li> <li>Spare tire</li> <li>Trailer Aid tire change lift ramp</li> <li>Registration / insurance for truck &amp; trailer</li> <li>Extra halter, bridle, reins and lead rope</li> <li>Rake / shovel / broom</li> <li>Extra fuses for truck and trailer</li> <li>Tool kit: phillips and flat screwdriver, hammer, wrench, utility knife, wire cutters, tie down straps, socket wrench</li> <li>Optional items:</li> <li>Binoculars</li> <li>Plastic 8'x10' tarp</li> </ol>
