



QCMP SAR EQUIPMENT CHECKLIST

1. Purpose – The Queen Creek Mounted Sheriff's Posse Search and Rescue team must be able to fully support search and rescue operations without jeopardizing the health and well being of their animals, themselves, and the Group and without relying on others. Each member shall be able to provide food, water, equipment and supplies for their equine and themselves for up to three days.
2. Equipment – Each member of the Queen Creek Mounted Sheriff's Posse Search and Rescue team shall own, maintain in good working order, and have the following times at all search callouts and training exercises.

SAR items needed at all times:

- ___ 1. Slicker / poncho (rain gear)
- ___ 2. Toilet paper / tissues
- ___ 3. Strike anywhere matches in a waterproof container
- ___ 4. Compass
- ___ 5. Notebook and writing tools
- ___ 6. Trail marking tape – 2 colors florescent
- ___ 7. Whistle
- ___ 8. Signal mirror
- ___ 9. First aid kit (see Equipment List)
- ___ 10. Multi-tool / Leatherman / pocket knife
- ___ 11. Flashlight with strobe option
- ___ 12. Nylon paracord (50 feet)
- ___ 13. Sharpie markers
- ___ 14. Emergency "space" blanket
- ___ 15. Leather string / twine, etc.
- ___ 16. Canteen or other suitable water container
- ___ 17. Water purification tablets or "Life Straw"
- ___ 18. Collapsible water bucket / dog dish
- ___ 19. Portable phone battery charger
- ___ 20. Sunscreen
- ___ 21. Insect repellent
- ___ 22. Duct tape
- ___ 23. Sewing kit
- ___ 24. Disposable gloves (latex free)
- ___ 25. Gorilla Glue /super glue
- ___ 26. Extra batteries for flashlight
- ___ 27. Snacks, jerky, nuts, protein bars
- ___ 28. Water - 1 gallon per day required
- ___ 29. Sunglasses
- ___ 30. Cell phone

Items for overnight operations kept in truck or trailer:

- ___ 1. Sleeping bag, sleeping mat
- ___ 2. Tent – one person "backpack" type
- ___ 3. Hand towel
- ___ 4. Metal or other non-breakable drinking cup
- ___ 5. Eating utensils (fork, knife, spoon, etc.)
- ___ 6. Portable stove / fuel or ready to eat meals
- ___ 7. Medicine, personal hygiene items
- ___ 8. Food to stay away from base for 2 nights for equine / human

Recommended items for truck or trailer:

- ___ 1. Picket rope or high-line
- ___ 2. Water / feed buckets
- ___ 3. Water – 15 gallons per equine / per day
- ___ 4. Equine feed – grain, hay, etc.
- ___ 5. Emergency flares
- ___ 6. Safety triangles / road markers
- ___ 7. Fire extinguisher
- ___ 8. Wheel chocks
- ___ 9. Jumper cables
- ___ 10. Spare tire
- ___ 11. Trailer Aid tire change lift ramp
- ___ 12. Registration / insurance for truck & trailer
- ___ 13. Extra halter, bridle, reins and lead rope
- ___ 14. Rake / shovel / broom
- ___ 15. Extra fuses for truck and trailer
- ___ 16. Tool kit: phillips and flat screwdriver, hammer, wrench, utility knife, wire cutters, tie down straps, socket wrench

Optional items:

- ___ 1. Binoculars
- ___ 2. Plastic 8'x10' tarp
- ___ 3. Pruning shears / folding saw / machete / ax
- ___ 4. 2 large contractor trash bags
