24 Hour Pack Contents Carried On Your Body

Navigation Kit Contents

1. Compass

2. Pencils, pens

3. Notebook

4. Protractor

5. Ruler

6. UTM/MGRS Ruler

7. Sharpie markers

8. GPS / mobile phone

Compass Requirements

- 1. Accurate to 1 degree
- 2. Protractor type base
- 3. Sighting mirror
- 4. Declination offset design
- 5. Liquid dampened
- 6. Suitable for night use

Emergency Kit Contents

- 1. Whistle
- 2. 4 safety pins
- 3. 2 single edge safety razors
- 4. Strike anywhere, matches in a waterproof
- 5. 2 large heavy duty "contractor" garbage bags
- 6. Space blanket
- 7. Signal mirror
- 8. Water purification tablets or "Life Straw"
- 9. 2 glow sticks

Tool Kit Contents

- 1. Flashlight with strobe option
- 2. Multi-tool, pocket knife
- 3. Trail marking tape 2 colors florescent

24 Hour Pack Contents Carried On Your Equine Or Backpack

- 1. 50 feet nylon paracord
- 2. Duct tape
- 3. Sewing Kit
- 4. Water 2 quarts minimum
- 5. Fire Kit fire starters, waterproof matches, lighter
- First Aid Kit human and equine (see Equipment List)
- Tack Repair Kit leather straps, chicago screws, twine
- 8. Ziplock bags multiple sizes9. Snacks: jerky, protein bars, nuts
- 10. Insect repellent
- 11. Easy Boot / trail boots
- 12. Collapsible water bucket or dog dish
- 13. Portable phone battery charger
- 14. Toilet paper / tissues in a ziplock bag
- 15. Extra batteries for flashlight
- 16. Food enough for four meals, no cooking required
- 17. Medicine and personal hygiene items
- 18. Sunscreen

Additional Suggested Items

- 1. Hat (with ear protection)
- 2. Socks (two pair)
- 3. Leather gloves for heavy brush work
- 4. Rain gear: slicker, saddle slicker
- 5. Head lamp w/extra batteries and bulb
- 6. Pruning shears, ax, machete, folding saw
- 7. Hoof pick
- 8. Comb / pick

48 Hour Pack Contents Left in Truck Or Trailer

All Items Contained In The 24 Hour Pack, Plus The Following:

- 1. One person tent, "backpack" tent or emergency tent
- 2. Sleeping bag
- 3. Insulated sleeping pad
- 4. Ground cloth or tarp
- 5. Mess Kit: portable stove or MRE's (meals ready to eat), utensils, cup, plate
- 6. Extra clothing all clothing carried in the pack should be in waterproof bags
- 7. Extra food and water for self and equine (15 gal water per day / per equine)
