3) Committee Reports

- ACC (Architectural Control Committee)
 - After many visits from Steve Williams, the City Manager has agreed to put WLM concerns on upcoming Agenda regarding:
 - No Outlet Signage at Entrance
 - No Parking Signage at Mailbox
 - Concerns are parked cars are affecting Handicap Ramp & School Walkway Access (City may need to collaborate with Post Office)
 - Steve will touch base in a few weeks and report at June meeting
- Joe Johnson installed dusk to dawn solar lighting at the WLM Entrance. If this is effective, no further action will be needed (in-ground electrical lights were also discussed)
- Reminder from Steve Williams that the City now requires annual updates on your bioswales. These are up to each individual homeowner

- Due to sidewalk moss/weeds along turf at entrance to WLM, our Landscaper will be contacted for pricing on pressure washing. Joan Roberts will also ask them for removal of obvious storm debris in additional contracted areas
- Reminder to homeowners to please remove limbs & debris from the street in front of your house, in addition to moving basketball hoops & vehicles so that street sweepers can keep the streets clean
