After discussion, Board President John Funderburg pointed out the CCR already includes specific building improvements and felt further explanation is not needed.

After discussion, Joan Roberts will reach out to our current landscaper Creekside Meadows to determine the cost of maintaining these areas. A motion was made by Joan Roberts & seconded by Julie Adams to authorize an increase of up to \$30.00 per month to cover the additional maintenance.
