As dictated by the <u>Berkeley Municipal Code</u>, "Construction, Contractor, and Household" sound, as well as "Domestic Power Tools and Machinery" sounds, are only allowed to be used from 7AM-7PM on weekdays, and 9AM-8PM on weekends.

Further, there is notation for the Exterior Noise Standards in the <u>BMC 13.40.050</u>, in which specific noise levels are not to be exceeded more than 30 minutes any hour, which they currently are (*if they are*).

Additionally, interior noise standards dictated in the <u>BMC 13.40.060</u> have specifications for the level of noise permitted inside residential buildings which I (*also*) believe are in violation.

What I have been experiencing is in violation of these regulations. Please let me know the plan for how long this is expected to last, and how my concerns will be addressed in a timely manner.
