

2023 Boston Juneteenth Parade Rules and Regulations

The annual Boston Juneteenth Emancipation Observance parade is a celebration of African American heritage in recognition of the Juneteenth holiday, as well as to recognize the rich legacy and myriad contributions of peoples of African descent to civilization. All entries must provide family-oriented entertainment consistent with the celebration of Juneteenth and freedom.

Parade officials are authorized to exclude or reject any such groups or persons found to not be in compliance with the rules regardless of previous agreements, arrangements or contracts.

Rules and Regulations:

- All participants expecting to wear or carry flags, banners or other materials bearing messages and/or identifications must register not later than June 9th with the Boston Juneteenth Committee Parade Team. The Parade Team will approve appropriate submissions and assign them a place in the parade line-up.
- Individuals wishing to walk in the parade as supportive members of the community are welcomed and must register not later than June 9th.
- The parade has no provisions for floats.
- Alcohol and drugs are strictly prohibited in the parade and on associated grounds.
- Vulgarity, hate and inappropriate speech whether written, spoken or broadcast are prohibited. The parade is non-sectarian and non-partisan.
- Parade participants must comply with instruction from parade organizers and managers thus assuring the best, most gracious experience for all.
- The Boston Juneteenth Committee encourages the wearing of costumes, but any nudity or indecent attire of any kind will not be tolerated.
- Participants must sign the parade liability waiver.
