A NEW YEAR AND A RENEWED PURPOSE

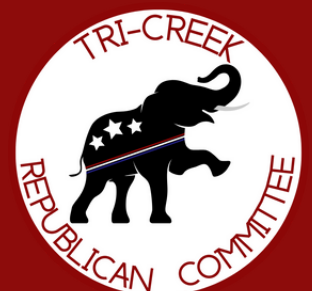
The Tri-Creek Republican Committee and the Lake County Republican Central Committee are both revamping this year. It is sure to be an exciting year!
