- 2. Efie S. talked about a discounted opportunity to purchase QuickBooks through the Tech Soup website. Tina E. applied to this website some days ago and the offer is \$75 for a year access to QuickBooks. There was consensus on purchasing the QuickBooks.
- 3. Tim J. said that it would be better to ask for donation a different time of the year because around the Christmas period the church asks for donation and stewardship. He said that the church usually sends a spiritual letter from the priest, a letter from the stewardship committee with a stewardship card for the New Year and an envelope for the Christmas donation. These donations help the church to cover operational costs. Andy T. and Efie S. agreed that it is a good idea not to ask for end of the year donations and wait for another occasion to do it.

Efie S., Andy T. and Tim J. said that we should discuss this topic more next week and try to find a convenient day for everyone in December.
