### Minutes

1. Everyone in the meeting approved the meeting minutes of August 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023. Efie will upload them on the website.

**2 & 3.** Tina E. gave updates about the Thanos Petrelis event and the sponsorship status. She said that by the time of the meeting there were 3 sponsors outside of the Greek community. Tina E. mentioned that Sofia Makris agreed to help finding sponsors for the event. Sofia Makris will contact potential sponsors from her personal

list of contacts. Tina E. will start approaching personally people who may want to sponsor the event. Tina E. shared that the Greek church of Holy Trinity in Phoenix started promoting the Thanos Petrelis event in their parish and she hopes that the other Greek churches in Phoenix will do the same. Tina E. and Tim J. expressed the need to give more details to the St. Demetrios parishioners about the organization of the Thanos Petrelis event. Peter A. shared that there are misunderstandings in the parish in regards of the cost of the event. Peter A. said that we should make clear to the parishioners that the cost for the Thanos Petrelis funds does not come from the church funds but 100% of the cost will be covered by the capital campaign funds. Everyone agreed that the capital campaign committee needs to send a document at the St. Demetrios church with the facts about the Thanos Petrelis concert. Tina E. agreed to send a document to Efie S. with such details and she will share it with the St. Demetrios office. Tina E. shared that AHEPA and Sofia Makris will help with the food during the Thanos Petrelis event and she will ask Kelly Aspiotis to find out if the Festival Committee is interested in helping with the food during the concert. Peter A. shared that there will be a brunch with Petrelis organized by the St. Demetrios Greek Orthodox Church Capital Campaign Foundation the day after the concert. He explained that there are two separate brunch events in October. The Petrelis brunch which is organized by the Capital Campaign Committee and the St Demetrios brunch which is organized by the church for the St. Demetrios name day. Tina shared that the amount raised until the time of the meeting is \$10,000 and the names of the sponsors of the event so far: Bruce and Nikki Halle, Alba and Nizar Sukkar (American Family Insurance), Alex and Helen Rodriguez (Gibson Insurance Group), Julie & Lee Horner and AHEPA. Tim J. asked if the mayor and the Pima County Board members are invited to the Petrelis event. Everyone agreed that it is an excellent idea and they will be invited. Tim J. shared that he will not be able to attend the concert and Tina shared that the mayor can sit on Tim J's table.

**4.** Peter A. shared that Tina E. works on the 501c3 status and the work is in process.

There was no time to discuss the rest of the agenda at this meeting. The rest of the topics will discussed at the next meeting. Efie S. encouraged everyone to have a look at the website to discuss it next time. Efie S. shared that she needs more information (dates, costs, details etc.) to include in the website.
