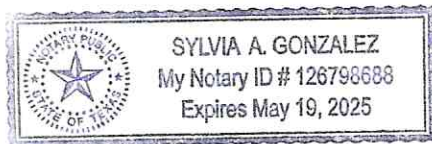



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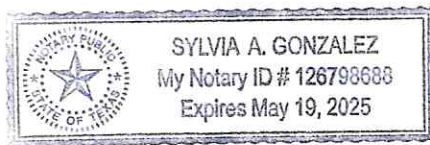

**SEALED BIDS** will be received at **City Administrator's Office, 121 N Arroyo Blvd., Rio Hondo, Texas, until 2 P.M. on January 31, 2023, and publicly opened, read, and taken under advisement** for the furnishing of all necessary materials, machinery, equipment, labor, superintendence, and all other services and appurtenances required for the construction of new walkways, roads, parking areas, lighting, piers, and buildings for the City of Rio Hondo Boat Ramp Park, and shall include acknowledgement of any addenda submitted, and all other documents included in said bid call. **SCOPE OF WORK:** The project shall include all materials, equipment, labor and supervision necessary for the successful construction of project site development, walking trails, parking spaces, roadways, fishing pier, lighting, sidewalks and ramps and parking lot overlay.

**CONTRACT TIME:** The Work shall be Substantially Completed within **210 Calendar Days**, and completed and ready for final payment within **330 Calendar Days**.
