We only see patients 18 years old or above.

II Immigration Exam fee will be \$200, excluding lab tests and immunization, and it is NOT covered by insurance. You can pay the exam fee by credit card or cash. We do NOT accept personal check.

III Certain blood tests and urine tests are required for the Immigration Exam. We do NOT collect blood and urine sample in our office. You will need to go to the lab to have the tests done (Fasting is not required). The blood tests, and urine test may not be covered by insurance, please check with the lab regarding the price. You will need to pay the lab fee directly to the labs.

Here are the lab tests required by USCIS Immigration Service

- Blood screening test for tuberculosis (QuantiFERON Gold), for all applicants aged 2 and older If a prior or current TB blood test is positive or "reactive", you will be required to do a Chest X-ray for an additional charge.
- 2) Blood screening test for syphilis (Required for applicants 18 to 44 years of age)
 All prior curative medical treatment for syphilis must be documented on the I-693 Medical Exam Form.
 A confirmatory syphilis test is required by law if the initial result from the first test is positive. An additional charge will apply.
 If syphilis is present, then, medical treatment is mandatory to be clear for USCIS/Immigration purposes. You will be referred to Florida department of health for treatment. Additional charge will

apply.

Urine screening test for gonorrhea (Required for applicants 18 to 24 years of age)
 If gonorrhea is present, medical treatment is mandatory to be clear for USCIS/Immigration purposes.
 You will be referred to the Florida department of health for treatment. An additional charge will apply.

IV Immunizations required by USCIS Immigration Services:

We will review your immunization record. You will need to get the required vaccines in local pharmacy if you have not completed the vaccination requirement in order for us to finish the I-693 form for you. **We do NOT administer vaccines in our office.**

If you do not have an immunization record, a blood titer test may be needed to determine if you are immune or need a booster. Additional lab fee will apply.

Regarding vaccines requirement, we follow the <u>CDC guideline for Civil Surgeons</u>.

All international immunization records in other languages other than English and Chinese must be officially translated into English.

V On the date of your appointment.

Please fill and bring the first 3 pages of <u>I-693 forms</u> and do not sign the section on page 2. You need to bring your unexpired passport or driver's license to your visit for identification purpose.

The I-693 form will be ready proximally one week after the lab tests are done and the required vaccines are obtained. Once your medical report is completed, the sealed envelope will be given to you to mail to USCIS. Please do not open the sealed envelope.

If you need additional sealed envelope without further examination, there will be additional \$60 fee.
