CCA Dress Code Policy 2021-2022

UNIFORM DAYS:

Specific CCA uniforms will be <u>required</u> 2 days a week. The students may wear the jeans, pants or shorts of their choice on these two days. Layering outer garments OVER the required uniform will not be permitted as it defeats the purpose.

- Wednesdays-Chapel Day-the students will be required to wear our collared CCA polo shirt with a pant or short of their choice. This shirt is provided and is included with tuition and fees.
- Fridays-Spirit Day-the students will be required to wear our CCA Lions spirit shirt with a pant or short of their choice. This shirt is provided and is included with tuitions and fees.

REGULAR CLOTHING DAYS:

Students should wear comfortable clothes that they can easily handle themselves when going to the bathroom.

- Shorts are acceptable to wear and skirts for girls when the weather allows, however they must be of an appropriate length. (fingertip)
- Clothing that has suggestive, inappropriate insignia or writing that does not adhere to the standards of CCA will be prohibited.
- Shirts should be long enough to cover the midriff area, and should have straps (no strapless tops).
- Please send one extra set of clothes for the student to keep in his or her homeroom. This should include pants, top, underwear and socks. We will change the student into the extra clothes if he or she requires it for any reason. Soiled clothes will be sent home in a plastic bag for you to wash. Please return another spare set the following school day. Please label all extra clothes, sweaters, and jackets with the student's first and last name with a permanent marker

SHOES:

Students should wear comfortable, well-fitting, age-appropriate shoes to school.

 Sneakers (tennis shoes) and socks are most appropriate as feet are well protected and provide proper support for outdoor activities.

- All shoes must be able to put on and off without adult assistance. The student should wear slip on shoes or velcro closing shoes if they cannot tie their own shoes.
- Sandals, boots, or shoes may be worn; however, tennis shoes with socks MUST be sent for PE and recess. The student MUST be independent enough to change out shoes without adult assistance.
- Flip Flops are prohibited (by students) for their safety.
- Heelies (shoes with inserted wheels) are prohibited

HATS AND JEWELRY:

- Girls not permitted to wear dangling or low hanging earrings
- Boys are not allowed to wear earrings
- No body jewelry will be allowed other than one single earrings for girls
- No necklaces or chains around the neck which pose a choking hazard
- Hats may not be worn inside the building

HAIR:

 Hair should be worn in a way to not be a distraction to the learning of your student or the learning of others (should not be too long and hanging in their eyes)
