Our Principles


Our Principles guide this strong sense of purpose and performance:

3BM's core purpose of building capability in the communities in which we operate defines how we work with traditional owner groups when planning for, and executing work. 3BM has a proven engagement model which allows us to connect with traditional owner groups and to understand the support and services required, and more importantly, the fundamental needs of the local area.

This model allows us to support and enable the direct participation of both traditional owners and the local community into the service offering and the execution of the scope of work.

As part of this, we are mindful of existing relationships between our clients and traditional owners, and we strive to capture and build on these relationships in a way that benefits both parties.



3BM prides itself on being able to work closely and flexibly with clients and partners to build sustainable outcomes.

We see ourselves as being able to deliver exceptional value through a few key avenues, including:

- providing an integrated solution that brings together key technical, operational and enhanced social benefits for each project;
- focusing on rehabilitation which drives superior technical, operational and financial outcomes;

- offering a unique connection to land through our commitment to meaningful engagement with the local traditional owners which ultimately enhances landforms, cultural value, post mining land use, and revegetation outcomes.



our services

3BM has the capability to perform all works associated with the progressive rehabilitation cycle across the mining, oil, gas and construction sectors. This includes the early stages of mine and gas field exploration and development, the operational phase, and the closure of mature sites. 3BM's capability covers all aspects from the initial technical assessment of soil, vegetation, waste, water and contaminates before any disturbance, through to the maintenance, monitoring and governance of rehabilitated and contaminated sites. The various activities are delivered through 3BM's in-house capability coupled with the capabilities of our strategic partners.

The execution of each of these capabilities is underpinned by input from the local traditional owners and communities. This not only ensures a more sustainable outcome, but allows us to incorporate options based on the local knowledge of the traditional owners and the wider community.





Shaping a rehabilitation outcome to the land from start to finish.

3BM's capabilities include:

- Reconciliation Action Plan support and drafting - assistance with engaging traditional owners and developing sustainable plans;
- Creation of post mining land use options driven by input by and consultation with the local community;
- Cultural Value Management Plan development working directly with local traditional owners;
- Pre disturbance environmental assessment and evaluation-technical and on ground support in pre disturbance on site works;
- De-vegetation, clearing and mulching vegetation and infrastructure clearing inclusive of mulching and storage of habitat sensitive trees;

- Drill site preparation ground preparation for exploration and production drilling;
- Drill hole rehabilitation grouting, waste disposal, reshaping and revegetation of drill hole sites;
- Load and haul and earthworks -topsoil and waste excavator, loader and truck operations;
- GPS controlled recontouring and reshaping
 dozer, loader and grader operations;
- Monitoring data gathering;
- Erosion infrastructure and maintenance repair earthworks to eroded rehabilitated areas;
- Revegetation, seeding, mulching and spray -grass - application of seed and mulch onto re-contoured sites.


These partnerships provide flexibility in both the scope and dimension of the services we are able to provide, and the depth of specialist knowledge we are able to offer when required.



- recycling and reducing waste.


