

Why the Program?

Youth mentorship is crucial for guiding young individuals towards their full potential. Mentors offer valuable insights, support, and encouragement, helping youth develop essential life skills and make informed decisions. Mentorship fosters personal growth, builds confidence, and empowers the next generation to overcome challenges and achieve their goals.

What is a Mentor?

A mentor is a PMI-certified project professional or an experienced project manager with at least three years of experience, who voluntarily provides friendly manner advice to students. Mentors are facilitators and catalysts in a process of discovery and insight. In a learning partnership, the mentor's role is to "guide on the side" rather than "be the expert with the answers."

What is a Mentee?

A mentee is a student enrolled in Grades 6-12 who is looking to obtain professional advice on starting or managing a project. Instead of being mentor-driven, with the mentor taking full responsibility for the mentee's learning, the mentee learns to share responsibility for the learning.
