Book Talk: The Art of Project Management: Strategies from Sun Tzu's Art of War

This book shows that project management can borrow insights from ancient philosophies.

Sun Tzu's *The Art of War*, a classic military strategy book, outlines timeless principles of strategy and tactics. Nelson Ortiz articulated in the book talk that these principles could be adapted to every process group of project management.

Ortiz emphasized the value of project management learning in (re)shaping youth's mindsets and behavior. Ortiz reminded the audience of the need to be creative in identifying stakeholders. "Even your enemy could be a stakeholder you want to (and have to) manage," as he stated.

On May 31, Mr. Nelson Ortiz delivered a virtual talk on his new book *The Art of Project Management:*Strategies from Sun Tzu's Art of War.




