- b. **First Friday** – We attend First Friday each month to provide information regarding volunteer opportunities along with information about services. We generally have raffle items and a 50/50.
 - i. Marty Adams, Chairman of the Board has agreed to help cover First Friday and attending Chamber Meetings.
 - c. **MC Street Team** – Participating with the MC Street Team to get resources, services and support information out to all the local communities.
 - i. Participation based on location, we can start attending other locations such as Bullhead and Lake Havasu with information about limited services such as Kingman Cares Connects.
- ### 7. Vehicle Report
- a. **Kingman Carrier-** Providing transportation for medical appointments, to the store and other. Volunteers for driving the van and providing transportation.
- ### 8. Wheelchair Ramps
- currently we have 2 volunteers repairing/building ramps, need more skilled volunteers in construction, also need more funds for building the ramps.
- ### 9. Internship Opportunities
- We have three Master Level Social Workers interning with us currently. Thank you Marty Adams and Micah Sealy for providing supervision.
- ### 10. Rent/Mortgage Assistance
- We currently do not have the resources. No grants pending to start this again at this time.
- ### 11. Utility Assistance
- We currently do not have the resources. No grants pending to start this again at this time

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Kingman Caring Home – July, a transitional group home has had once resident, based on his income he has been able to pay \$800.00 for the month. He is able to self ambulate however needs assistance getting his VA benefits set up so that as his health declines the CLC could potentially be an option for him.

We have had several other referrals that have been declined as the individuals were either not able to manage being a lone in the home for the majority of the time or concerns related to potential behavior that were beyond what we are able to safely provide for.

1. We need to meet with Mohave Community College and again with AZ @work for the student LNA/Nursing internship program so that we can get set up with more volunteers for more hours that are able to do more hands on care.
2. Expenses of running the care house are about \$3,000.00 a month. We need so secure ongoing funding.
 - a. A application has been submitted to the state for the employee contribution program. They do require the 990 long tax form, we do not have this so we did submit the 990N postcard to show we are current regarding tax reporting. Not sure this will be sufficient.
 - b. Another application has been submitted to KRMC for the employee contribution fund 2025. Again we cannot count on this as every year for the last three years, they have said next year.
 - c. We have a meeting scheduled mid September regarding an individual who is looking at making a contribution.
 - d. More fundraising is needed.
