7. Vehicle Report

a. **Kingman Carrier**- Toyota 2006, minivan. To provide transportation for medical appointments, to the store and other. We had the Day of Caring Community Fair making enough to pay for new tires and supplies for the

vehicle. Thank you to Christina Brazil and her husband who came out and helped with the fundraiser and donated the new battery.

Volunteers for driving the van and providing transportation: 2 both have provided their driving records and are registered on the insurance.

Logs: There is a book that remains in the vehicle to log transportation, deliveries, who is driving when, miles, donations, maintenance, and cleaning.

Need to reach out to auto body shops to see if one will provide in-kind donations to fixing up the outside of the van.

b. Other:

- i. Wheelchair Ramps we currently have two requests.
 - 1. Letters need to be sent to contractors in the community requesting in-kind donations of materials and labor for some of the larger ramps.
- ii. **DME Supports to Hualapai and Supi Reservations** Providing supplies such as DME, diapers, chucks, concentrators, and more on quarterly basis.
- iii. **April**: 9 wheelchairs, 4 walkers, 1 rolators, 6 commodes, 1 shower chair, 2 oxygen concentrators, 4bags of adult diapers, 5 packages of chucks.
- iv. **Internship Opportunities** We have two Master Level Social Workers interning with us currently.
 - Contracts currently with Grand Canyon University, Walden University, and Arizona State University for Master Level Social Work Interns.
- v. **Rent/Mortgage Assistance** We currently do not have the resources.
 - 1. No grants pending to start this again at this time
- vi. **Utility Assistance** We currently do not have the resources.
 - 1. No grants pending to start this again at this time
- vii. **Hotel Assistance** –We currently do not have the resources.
 - 1. No grants pending to start this again at this time
- viii. **Coats for Winter** We still have coats available if someone needs a light weight jacket or needs a coat for travels.
- ix. **Hope Lives**-Kingman Cares partnered with Hope Lives providing clothing, shoes and personal care items.

- x. **Car Seats:** who are not able to afford a car seat or replace one when needed.
 - 1. One given out this month, 20 provided to other agencies to pass out.

8. New Business:

- a. **Kingman Caring Home** July, a medical group home for those who maybe unsheltered or have a home and no care provider. These individuals will need home health, wound care, or hospice services and a safe place temporarily. This is not an assisted living facility or a long-term care facility; however, it provides the individual a safe place with supports and case management to move into a safe long-term option. Price will be based on 80% of individuals income or the facility they are working with paying to \$1,500.00 a month to cover expenses.
 - At this time the hose is not available for us to start preparing,
 Marcia Joslin will notify the team as soon as possible available.
