Volunteer Opportunities

There are lots of oppertunities to volunteer for individuals, coples, groups, organizations, and businesses. There are opportunities to work with individuals, one-to-one or in groups.

Twice a year Kingman Cares partners with River Cities United Way, the Clean City Commission, the Downtown Merchants Association, Cactus Cleaners and the Rotary Club. We invite you, your family, your group, organization, or business to join us in cleaning up the streets in the Kingman Community. Along with this we offer to help people clean up their yards, get rid of old appliances. We need volunteers to help for the elderly and disabled who are not able to pull weeds or remove debris from their yard due to health concerns or conditions. This is an opportunity for everyone to be able to volunteer time twice a year; April and September.

We have volunteer opportunities to visit the homebound. For those who are not able to get out and have no family or friends to visit or help them, these volunteers are most valuable. It gives them a connection to the outside world, to connect with someone else and sometimes even a reason to go on. These volunteers visit their person a couple times a month and can assist with running errands, shopping, helping keep track of medical appointments, sometimes light housework like a sink full of dishes or light cooking such as preparing a crockpot roast for the week. Volunteers are not paid care providers, they are not able to change diapers, give baths or other personal care items. They are not housekeepers and do not come out to clean up people's houses. This is a very rewarding position as often times the individuals needing a volunteer has no one else to help them.

Transportation, we have many opportunities for volunteers to provide transportation assistance. Many people need help getting to and from medical appointments. They need assistance getting to the grocery store and a way back home with their groceries. Volunteers can use their own vehicle or the Kingman Carrier minivan to transport people.

Events, Kingman Cares sets up booths at different events including Frist Friday and many others, we need volunteers to attend and work the events. This helps get the word out as to services offered and the need as an opportunity to fundraise.

Volunteers with professional trade experience such as carpenters and builders to help with building and repairing wheelchair ramps and installing safety bars. Mechanics to do minor repairs on vehicle in order for individuals to be able to get themselves to/from their own appointments.

Deliveries, delivering and pick up durable medical equipment. Going to the store and getting groceries for people.
