RIFLE AND PISTOL SAFETY RULES

Our Range Safety Rules are for your personal safety and also the peace and safety of those in the vicinity. **Please read and heed the following safety rules.** Deviation from these rules will result in immediate removal and possible dismissal from YSA.

YOU ARE REQUIRED TO KNOW ALL THE RULES AND COMMANDS BEFORE SHOOTING! "Shooters" will cooperatively carry out range firing instructions when Range Officer is not immediately present.

ALL SHOOTERS MUST SIGN IN BEFORE SHOOTING:

- 1. Safety! Safety! Safety is our main concern!
- 2. Wear a mask if you are going to be less than 6 feet away from anyone. Wash hands frequently.
- 3. EYE AND EAR PROTECTION IS REQUIRED ON ALL RANGES.
- 4. After firing or when "CLEAR YOUR FIREARMS" is called, all shooters will make their guns safe by emptying the magazine of all ammunition, locking actions open, insert chamber flag, and placing firearm on the table with muzzle pointed down range, chambers visible for inspection, then step behind the yellow poles.
- 5. When **SAFE ON THE LINE** is called, all persons wishing to go down range may do so. Those people not going down range shall remain behind the yellow poles and will **NOT** handle anything on the benches.
- 6. **CLEAR TO FIRE** shall be called before anyone steps forward to the benches and commences fire. At this time, you may add or remove firearms.
- 7. All firearms shall be racked when not in use with actions open. Muzzleloaders shall not be capped or primed until ready to fire
- 8. Only single trigger pull firing is allowed. NO RAPID FIRE, NO DOUBLE TAPS, NO UNAIMED SHOOTING, NO SHOOTING FROM THE HOLSTERS, AND SHOTGUNS WITH SLUGS ONLY! This is for the safety of all.
- 9. Shoot only approved targets in the frame directly in front of you. Absolutely no cross firing.
- 10. Shooting stations shall be left neat and cardboard in the target boxes.
- 11. No Person, will hand a loaded firearm to another individual. The shooter must show total proficiency that is, be able to LOAD, UNLOAD, and make Firearm Safe, on their own accord. Safety is our main concern
- 12. . Illegal firearms are NOT permitted
- 13. No person who is obviously under the influence of alcohol or other substance will be allowed to shoot. No alcoholic beverages of any kind will be allowed at any time inside the fences fronting the ranges. **IF YOU DRINK YOU DO NOT SHOOT!**
- 14. YSA policy requires the knowledge of the English language in order to read the safety rules and understand range commands. If the shooter cannot read or speak the English language, the shooter must provide an interpreter
- 15. No person under 18 years of age may shoot on YSA ranges unless accompanied by and under direct supervision of a legal adult.
- 16. No targets shall be used on the rifle and pistol ranges that are larger than YSA cardboard. Do not use more than one frame without permission.
- 17. Do not attach targets to frames.
- 18. No metal or reactionary targets allowed!
- 19. Spent lead shall not be removed from the range or the backstop embankments
- 20. No person shall be allowed behind the embankment or anywhere near the bullet embankment areas during firing.
- 21. Pets are not allowed inside the firing area fences.
- 22. YSA will not be responsible for lost or stolen items
- 23. The range will be closed to all persons except contestants during a YSA designated event
- 24. Club Officer, Range Officers and the Manager shall have absolute control of the facility.
