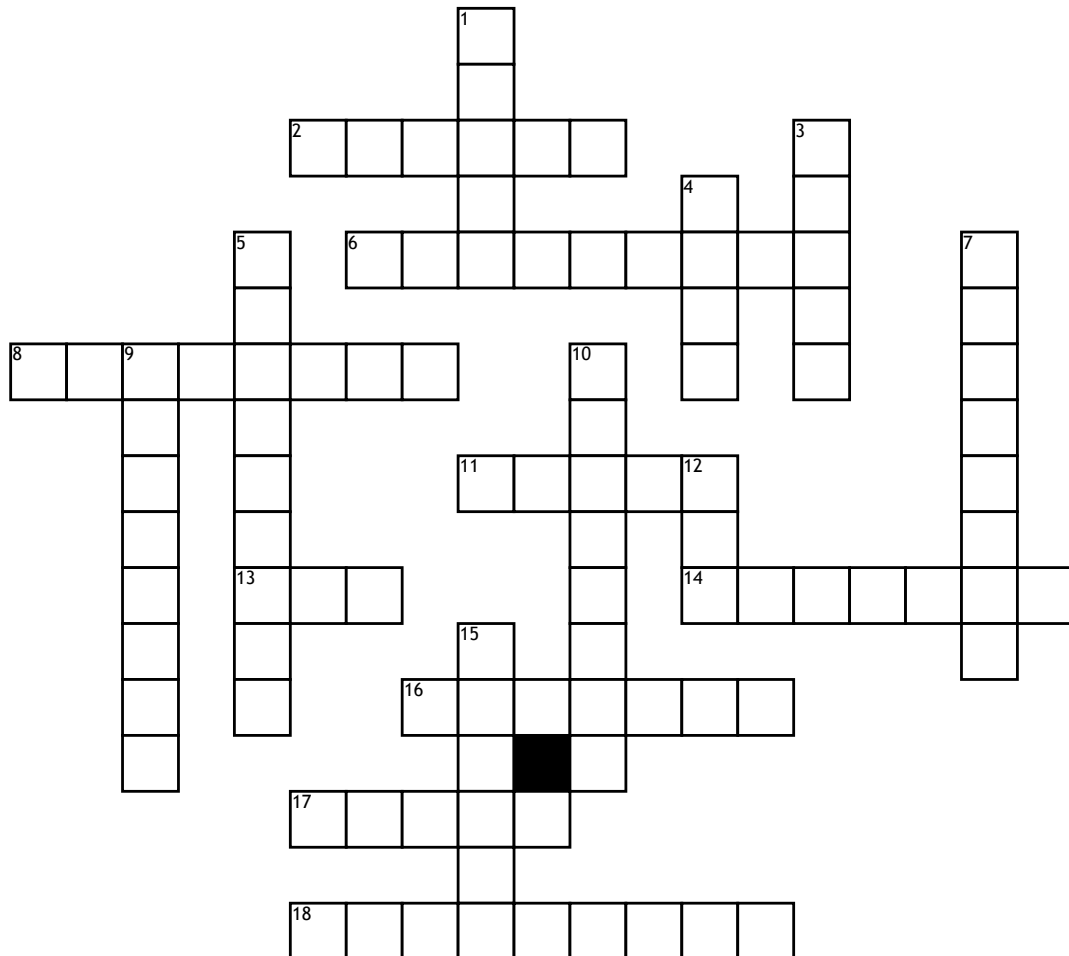

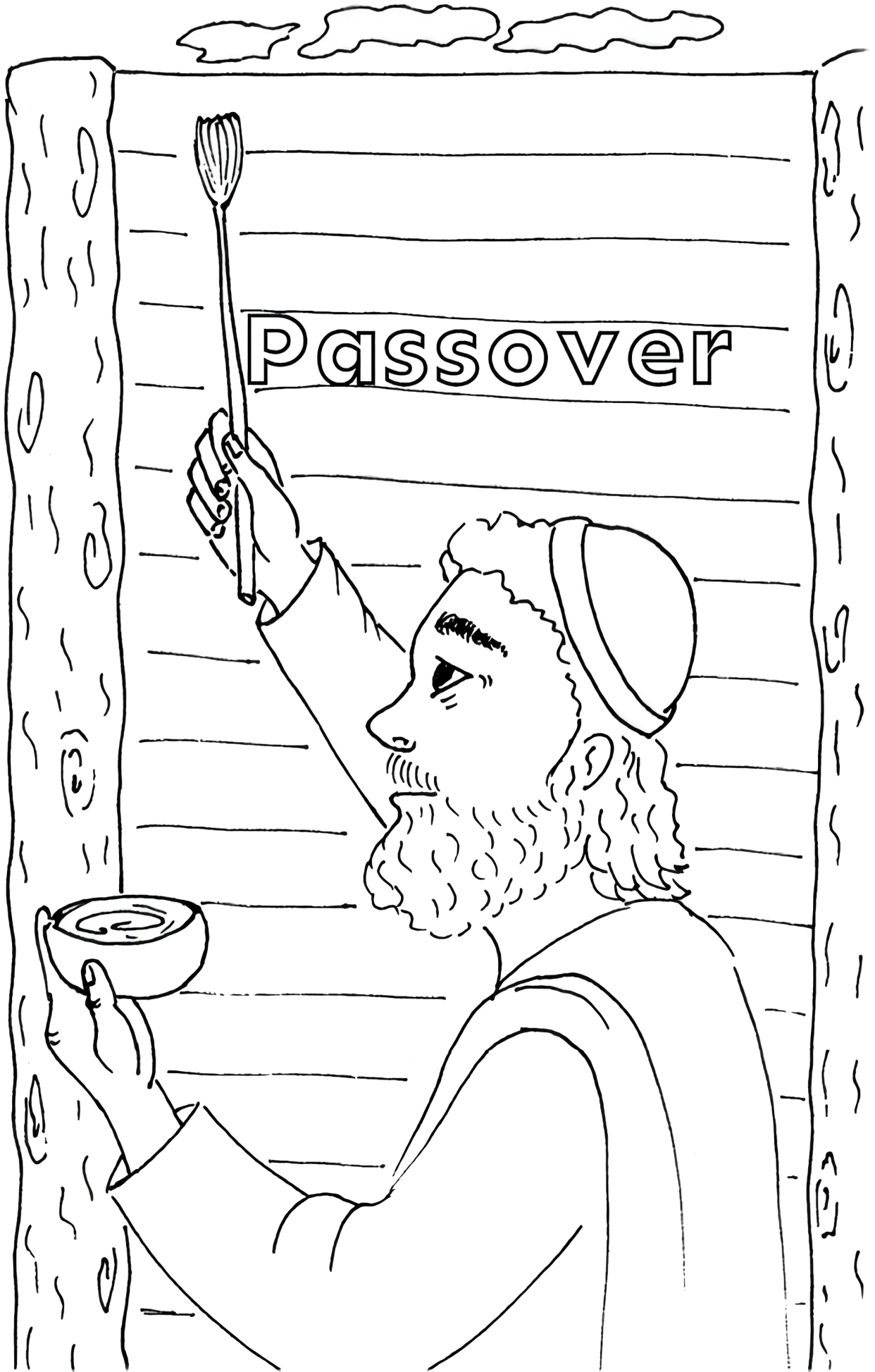

The following craft ideas are from Lessons in Yeshua's Torah

Tambourines!

Using paper plates, help the children make tambourines to shake as they sing. Use either string or staples to secure two plates together—facing each other so they can hold beans or bells. Decorate the tambourines with bells, ribbons, and colorful designs.

Things you'll need:

Beans

Small bells

Stapler

Ribbons

Paper plates

Hole puncher

String or yarn

Crayons or colored pencils

Unleavened Bread

Let the children help make unleavened bread.

Things you'll need:

1 cup flour (extra for dusting)

1/2 teaspoon salt

2 tablespoons extra virgin olive oil (extra for greasing cookie sheet)

1/2 cup water Also:

Rolling pin

Parchment paper

Cookie sheet

Preheat oven to 350°F. Combine the ingredients, and then place the dough on a floured surface. Knead the dough for five minutes. Roll it out to about 1/8th inch thick. On either parchment paper or a greased cookie sheet, bake for 20 minutes.

Paper Plate Frog Craft

Have the kids paint the back of a paper plate green and the inside of the plate pink. Then fold the plate so that it looks like a frog's mouth. Glue googly eyes on the top, paper legs on the bottom, and a long, rolled paper tongue on the inside of the folded plate.

Things you'll need:

Paper plates

Green paint or markers

Pink paint or markers

Green paper

Red paper or ribbon

Googly eyes

Glue

Crossing the Sea!

Help the children with a simple paper craft. Fold a piece of paper as shown, with both ends meeting in the middle. Color the top of the paper blue for water, front and back. Color the underneath side brown for ground. Lift the water to reveal dry ground.
