



However, she still has her maternal grandmother, who at 93, still makes David and Kayla cinnamon rolls! David is a middle child (he has a sister and two brothers). David's mom is in Menasha and his dad resides in Florida. David was born in the Upper Peninsula (check out small towns of Gwinn and Soumi) and moved with his mom and siblings to Menasha when he was 9 years old. Kayla giggled and said, "I haven't left the Fox Cities yet!" David's paternal grandpa still lives in the U.P., at a sprightly age of 73. He journeys down to the Fox Cities to attend car shows with David on occasion.

David credits that Grandpa with teaching him much about automobiles. David's brother also had some influence . . . David recalls the two brothers having torn apart at 1972 Nova and putting it back together. He said it never ran again!! But, David has learned much about vintage autos since then! MAFFI Newsletter Minute (Model A Ford Foundation, Inc), Hickory Corners, MI

For starters, a little history of the Model A Foundation, Inc.: In 1984, trustees of the Model A Ford Club of America (MAFCA) began to discuss formation of a foundation with tax exempt, charitable status. By 1987, a separate organization, MAFFI, was officially recognized, with the goal of building a museum dedicated to the preservation of the Model A Ford car and related items of the era.

The foundation grew and developed plans to build, and finally settled on the Gilmore location (in Hickory Corners, MI). The current building was completed in the fall of 2012, and the Grand opening was held in May, 2013. Membership has steadily grown, and MAFFI has not had an increase in dues since well before the Museum existed.

However, the cost of operating the Museum has continued to rise. The MAFFI Board of Trustees, in careful consideration of all the facts, has voted to implement the following dues structure, effective May 1, 2023. Note that each membership includes the named member and spouse/domestic partner.
