There has been much careless damage to the rifle and pistol ranges. Damage to the target holders or any other range equipment or club property will not be tolerated. Target holder frames are not to be used as targets! Any person shooting directly at wooden posts or steel target holders or causing deliberate damage to any part of the club's property will have their membership revoked and criminal charges will be filed against them! Respect club property and follow the rules. The use of shot shells or rifles ARE NOT permitted on the Pistol Range in any form.

Also, to members that use the archery ranges. The use of the broadhead is strictly forbidden! You are destroying the targets. If you are caught using broadhead arrows your membership will be revoked.

Rifle and Bow Range Usage

A reminder to members that the pistol range, rifle range and bale archery ranges are open daily, year-round, during daylight hours. Anyone using these ranges <u>MUST</u> be a club member in good standing. Guests may accompany but are not permitted to handle any firearm or bow.

THE SNIPER RANGE IS ONLY OPEN DURING THE PAID EVENT.

All members using the ranges MUST display their membership card.
