## **HURRICANE SEASON**

## **ISLAND MOORINGS MARINA SLIP HOLDERS**

June 1<sup>st</sup> Hurricane Season begins. This is the time to begin your preparations.

**CONDITION 5:** Hurricane Season begins.

• Check your lines, chafing gear and fenders. Ensure ALL are in good condition.

**CONDITION 4:** A Tropical Depression, Storm, or Hurricane is within a **1200 mile** radius of Island Moorings Marina.

Note: Progression of Condition 4 to Condition 1 can happen swiftly.

- Lift Holders Vessels are to be <u>LOWERED</u> and secured to dock no later than Condition 3.
- Boats that can be put on trailers Owner's should seriously consider moving to higher ground.

**CONDITION 3:** 72 – 48 Hours to Storm Landing.

- Prepare to Evacuate, <u>NO ONE</u> is to remain aboard a vessel during a storm.
- Secure all gear/belongings; begin to clear decks and docks.

**CONDITION 2:** HURRICANE WATCH HAS BEEN ISSUED **48 – 36 Hours** to Storm Landing.

- No loose gear on decks or docks.
- Check Lines

**CONDITION 1**: Hurricane warning has been issued; 24 Hours to Storm Land Fall.
