LMFAO Youth Advisory Board (YAB) Description

Our YAB aims to share research ideas, work together, provide feedback on ongoing projects, and interpret study findings. We encourage teens ages 13–17 who live in Wisconsin and are interested in LGBTQIA2S+ health, digital media, and service-leadership to apply.

What's the commitment?

- **Membership:** The term is one year. You are able to re-join the YAB as long as you are still between ages 13-17 years old.
- **Meetings:** We will meet 4 times per school year on Zoom and will set the schedule at the first meeting based on everyone's availability. Each meeting will have a topic related to youth, well-being, social media, and LGBTQIA2S+ health. YAB members commit to attending at least 3 out of 4 meetings.
- Messages: Between meetings, you will be asked to engage in the YAB group chat on Discord at least once a month.

What do I gain?

- A \$125 stipend
- At least 10 volunteer hours
- Professional, writing, research, and leadership skills
- Ability to contribute to cuttingedge research on digital media
- A letter of recommendation from an adolescent medicine physician
- Networking opportunities with teens across Wisconsin who are interested in LGBTQIA2S+ health, digital media, and leadership.
