

## MAKE A SUMMERTIME FIREFLY!

What you will need:

1 large plastic egg (like the kind the Easter Bunny might bring)

1 battery operated tea light (available at any dollar store)

White tissue paper

Permanent marker

Googly eyes (optional)

Craft glue or tape (or glue gun if a grown up is helping you)

1 craft pipe cleaner

Step 1:

Using your marker, draw a face on the very end of the **ROUNDED** side of the plastic egg. If you are using googly eyes, glue them on at this time.

Step 2:

Bend your pipe cleaner in half so it is shaped like the letter V and roll the 2 ends into balls or circles, so they look like antennae.

Step 3:

Attach the antennae to the more rounded side of the plastic egg just behind the face you just drew. You will need to bend the pointy end of

the V so it is flat against the egg. You can use tape or craft glue or get a grown up to help you use a glue gun.

Step 4:

Cut 2 raindrop shapes out of your tissue paper. They should be about the same size as your plastic egg. These will be the firefly's wings.

Step 5:

Glue or tape the wings just behind the antennae. If you need more room, you might need to attach them on the "pointy" half of the egg.

Step 6:

Turn your tea light on and place it inside the plastic egg so it sits in the pointy side of the egg.

Step 7:

Close the egg and enjoy your firefly!!
