## Barn Rules

1. Absolutely no smoking or open flame is permitted in the barn or surrounding areas.
2. No over-night sleeping in the barn is permitted unless approved in advance.
3. Please complete a stall card with the name of the horse and emergency contact information. This may be attached to the stalls with painter's tape or by attachment to the stall bars with string or other material which will not damage the finish.
4. Altering the stalls in any way (nails, staples, screw eyes, etc) is strictly forbidden. Screw eyes have been provided for your convenience. If you need additional fasteners, contact the facility coordinator or an officer of Wicomico Equestrian Club, Ltd.
5. Acceptable bedding is shavings, sawdust, or wood pellets. Straw is not permitted.
6. Please dispose of soiled bedding in designated areas only.
7. Please dispose of trash in proper receptacles. You may put shavings bags in the dumpster located near the Parks Department maintenance building to reduce volume in trash cans.
8. No cross tying of horses in barn aisle. Keep aisle clear for horse and pedestrian traffic.
9. Do not tie horses to the stall door or the window bars.
10. No washing horses in the barn aisle. Wash areas are provided outside each barn. Please clean up after your horse in the wash area.
11. All dogs must be leashed and if left unattended must be restrained so as to not reach the center of the aisle.
12. Do not apply any preparations or medications in the barn aisle that might stain the floors (Kopertox, hoof oil, hoof paint, etc.).
13. No riding in the barn. Dismount before entering the barn.
14. No running or loud noise in the barn.
15. No electric heaters or refrigerators may be used. No electric cords may cross the barn aisle.
16. When vacating your stalls between shows, all manure and wet bedding must be removed. When vacating at the end of your rental period, all manure and bedding must be removed. Stalls which are not properly cleaned will be charged a cleaning fee.

***Be courteous to barn users and spectators. Consider the safety of horses and people. Please leave the barn as you found it. Help do your part to maintain the facility in a way in which we can all take pride.***
