



How Do I Take My Ancestors To The Temple?

Minimum Requirements for Temple Ordinances

- Name – minimum if first name
- Gender
- One Date – minimum of year (birth, death, marriage, etc)
- One Location – minimum of country (birth, death, marriage, etc)
- Date and location do not have to be for same event
- More info you have, more likely you are to find other family members

2 Steps for Submitting Ordinances

1. Enter the name and vital information into www.familysearch.org
2. Reserve the ordinances and print out the cards to take to the temple

General Tips and How to Navigate on FamilySearch.org

- Always use a female's maiden name; if not known, leave the box empty
- Do not use punctuation other than periods or commas
- Help Menu is on Top Right Corner of Website – call, insta-chat, email help
- Can adjust size of print on the website
- Go to Person Page View to enter or edit information or to search

Adding Ancestors to Your Tree

- Look for an ancestor that is missing family members such as a spouse, children, siblings, or parents
- Search to find those missing family members
- Once you locate family members, add them to that family by entering their name, gender, dates and locations of life events that you have found

Doing Their Temple Work

- After you enter each person, reserve their temple ordinances by clicking on the “Ordinances” tab on their Person Page
- Go to your “Temple” tab at the top of the screen
- Select those that you want to do ordinances for from your account
- Click on the drop down “Print” menu (blue button)
- Click on “Print Family Ordinance Cards”
- Follow other prompts to print out your cards
- Cut out cards on the dotted lines and take to the temple with you
